

TheNewDowse Gold Award

A \$10,000 award for New Zealand Jewellers

TheNewDowse Gold Award will allow the Winning Entrant to create a significant work in gold that will become a part of TheNewDowse's permanent collection.

Entry into the competition constitutes full and unconditional agreement to and acceptance of the Terms and Conditions outlined below.

Terms and Conditions

Special Conditions

- Entrants are required to design an original piece of jewellery in accordance with the following requirements:
 - The proposed design, when realised, must have a proven market value of at least \$5000.
 - Not less than \$5,000 worth of gold will be provided to the Winning Entrant to create the Winning Design. Entrants may incorporate all, or a portion of this amount of gold in their design.
 - A maximum of three A4 drawings of the proposed design must be submitted. Oversize entries will not be accepted.
 - A conceptual outline of the proposed design must be submitted with the drawings, together with an indicative project budget/critical path.
 - A maximum of six images of the Entrant's previous work may be submitted (either transparencies or disk). The Judges will not consider videos, films, additional slides or photographs, prototypes, models or any additional supporting materials of any type.
 - The Entrant's resume, outlining professional and exhibition histories must be submitted. Presentation folders or bindings should not be used.
 - The Entrant must include a statement outlining their previous experience relating to their work with gold or similar materials and the basis on which they believe they are capable of successfully executing the proposed work.
- The Winning Entrant will be presented with a total prize package to the value of \$10,000, comprised of not less than \$5,000 worth of gold and the balance in cash.
- The prize must be taken as offered and is not transferable for a full cash prize.
- All, or a portion of the gold must be used by the Winning Entrant to create the Winning Design, which shall become part of TheNewDowse's permanent collection. The completed work must have a proven market value of at least \$5000.
- The Winning Work must be completed to the specifications of the Winning Design and be made available to TheNewDowse on or before 4 September 2009.
- Any taxes incurred by claiming the prize are the responsibility of the Winning Entrant.
- The Winning Entrant agrees to transfer all rights and property of the Winning Design and Completed Work, including copyright, to the Hutt City Council.
- The Judges' decision will be made on the basis of the information required in clause 1 only.
- The Judges decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- Entries must be accompanied by a self-addressed envelope with sufficient postage for the return of the competition entry material.

General Conditions

- Entry into the competition constitutes full and unconditional agreement to and acceptance of these terms and conditions.
- Entry is open to all citizens and permanent residents of New Zealand except elected members or employees of Hutt City Council, or their immediate family members or persons living in the same household.
- No more than two entries per person will be accepted.
- Hutt City Council reserves the right to amend any or all of the terms and conditions due to unforeseen circumstances.
- Personal information provided for the purposes of the competition is collected and held by the Hutt City Council to enable it to communicate with entrants and select a winner for the competition.
- Entrants have the right under the Privacy Act 1993 to obtain access to and request correction of any personal information held by Hutt City Council about them.
- The Winning Entrant agrees to their name and image being used for promotional purposes.
- Entries must be received by 5.00 pm on Friday 3 April 2009. Entries should be mailed to Claire Regnault, TheNewDowse, PO Box 30 396, LOWER HUTT or delivered by hand or courier to 45 Laings Road, LOWER HUTT. Late entries will not be accepted.
